Confused about mosaics? We've got your answer!



Below, we've outlined a simple step-by-step guide to getting started with mosaics:

1. Tile: Choose your base surface, sketch your design if desired, then arrange tiles to fill in the design.







TIP: Cut tiles using a wheel mosaic nipper.

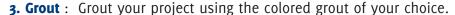
2. Glue: Use Weldbond as adhesive to glue tiles to the mosaic base. As you glue, leave a small gap in between tiles to leave room for grout. Allow glue to dry for 24 hours.







TIP: Use a cotton swab to glue each tile individually, or apply glue to small areas at a time then position tiles.









GROUTING INSTRUCTIONS: Pour grout into a disposable bowl. Use a plastic spoon to mix in small amounts of water until you achieve an oatmeal consistency. Spread grout mix over project surface, allowing the grout to fill in all gaps between the tiles. Wear plastic gloves to keep your hands clean. Allow project to dry for 10-15 minutes, then wipe off excess grout with a paper towel.
